Virtual classroom training

What does that mean?

Just as with classroom training in our training center or at your premises, virtual classroom training takes place with a personal trainer.

The difference to classroom training is that the participants do not sit in a room with the trainer, but take part in the training at their workplace or at home.

The core of this system is the virtual classroom. It offers your employees access to training regardless of their location. Participants can ask questions and interact with the trainer at any time, just as in classroom training. Rest breaks are planned and questions can be asked / answered. Response times taken into account.

To take part in an ABB Virtual Classroom Training, the participant only needs technical equipment such as an internet access, a PC or notebook, a headset and most importantly a webcam. This means that interaction with the trainer takes place at almost the same level as in the real classroom.

The participant will receive the training documents required for the course by e-mail in good time before the start of the course. This gives him or her time to print them out, if necessary, in order to make comments or notes just as in the classroom course.

ABB RobotStudio® is used for practical exercises.

The participants install this program on your computer before the training starts. If required, ABB provides a full license (term 30 days) free of charge.
